And unfortunately, flowers are the most common decoration accessories especially in weddings.

Well my friend, I have some good news for you. I have a few tips and tricks to help you create great decoration and save yourself some coins in the same process.



TIP #1 - ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS



Don't get it twisted... There are great and realistic artificial flowers out there. And let me tell you this, floral arrangement is the most crucial factor when it comes to flowers. Brush off your skeptical mind! What makes flowers so great is how you arrange them and not necessarily the nature (real or fake). The second factor is how many flowers you're putting together.

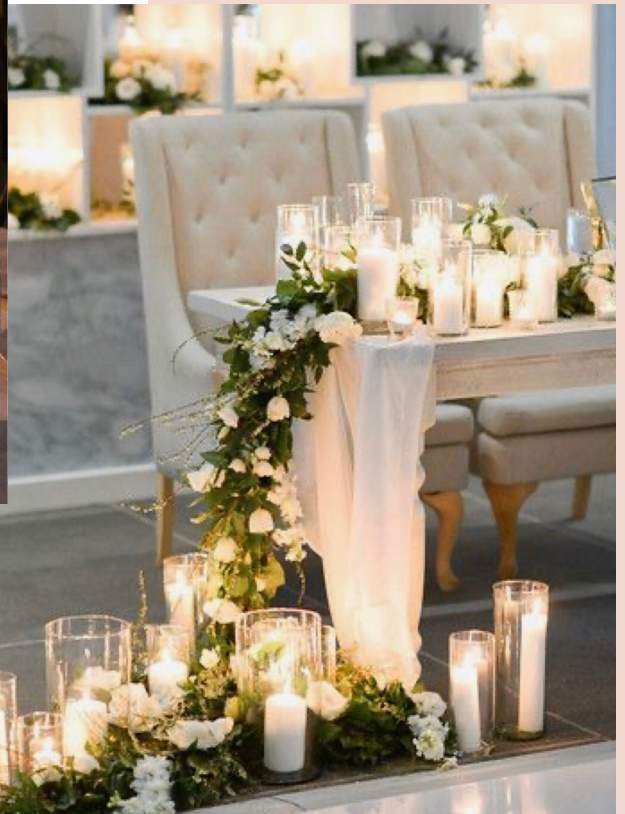
TIP #2 - CANDLES

Have you seen lately? More and more event planners/designers are using candles to replace flowers. I will sneak some pictures so you can see exactly what I'm talking about. My friend! This is a fantastic alternative to flowers. Because of their variety of shape, colours, length and size the possibilities are endless!!! Candles are perfect when you have a limited budget because of their bulk price and besides they're SO elegant. I personally love the combination of candles and vases. You can either put stand candles or floated candles in those vases and then add water, flowers or birds.



TIP #2 - CANDLES

Please keep in mind that candles have burning time so it's best to go with the finest quality when you do an event. You can also opt for electric candles but then you have to keep in mind a budget for the batteries. Luckily for you, with my researches I came across great vendors and shops who sell candles and vases. I even used them myself at past events. Do not hesitate to reach out if you want to get more information about this specific product. In the meantime, take a look at the following ideas that can work for you.



TIP #3 - BALLOONS



Yes you read it right. Balloons at weddings CAN be a thing! Be careful though, I'm not talking about those cheap balloons, no!. There's a variety of premium quality balloons that work just right for any big event. A beautiful 36 inches round balloon will provide a great statement decoration piece.

The biggest challenge with balloons it's more so to know how to do the arrangements (see pictures below). If you're on budget don't worry, there's plenty of DIY's video on Youtube that can explain how to achieve the assembly. If it doesn't work out, you can always visit a party supply store so they can help you with the arrangements. In my humble opinion, what works best it's mixing the size or to add drape, lights, greenery or artificial flowers. My budget-friendly advice is to shop at a local fabric stores and

buy the fabrics you need. Not only you'll get more options you will also save money! The best of both world! :) As for the pipes, I discovered great DIYs tutorial on Youtube using PVC pipes. I also plan to do short DIYs videos to help you out. Some installations are more complicated than others so if you plan to have drapes in the ceiling you will have to talk to the venue owner and hire professionals to install the set up. Either way, I guarantee you it will cost way more less than buying real flowers. Peep at the pictures below :)
